

Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Urgent Closure of: Waterhay, Leigh and Westfields Farm South East C70 To Waterhay Bridge, Ashton Keynes

WILTSHIRE COUNCIL HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that on 25th January 2021, the following lengths of road shall be closed to all traffic in the interests of public safety to enable Wiltshire Council to carry out carriageway reactive patching and associated maintenance works.

Phase One: Waterhay (Part), Leigh; from its junction with Swan Lane to its junction with Westfields Farm South East C70 To Waterhay Bridge.

Phase Two: Westfields Farm South East C70 To Waterhay Bridge, Ashton Keynes; from its junction with Waterhay to its access to Bridleway AKEY28.

Waterhay (Part), Leigh; from its junction with Westfields Farm South East C70 To Waterhay Bridge for a distance of approximately 200m in an easterly direction.

Alternative route:

Phase One: via Westfields Farm South East C70 To Waterhay Bridge, Happy Land, High Road, B4696, Swan Lane and vice versa.

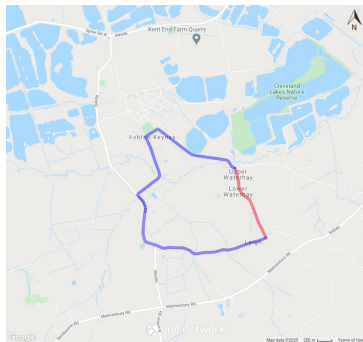
Phase Two: via Westfields Farm South East C70 To Waterhay Bridge (unaffected length), Happy Land, High Road, B4696, C419, C124 ,B4040, Jct with Bournelake Park East to Cross Roads Farm, Waterhay (unaffected length)

The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works.

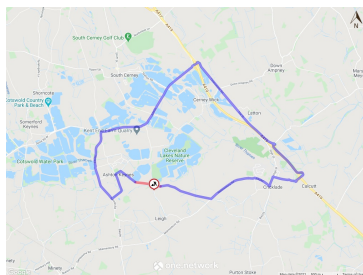
